About the Chico Art Center

Chico, California was ranked #10 in the "100 Best Art Towns in America" by author John Villani (4th ed). Villani said Chico ranked highly because it is "supportive, accessible and art oriented." Chico was the only town in California to make the top 10.

Chico Art Center is a nonprofit organization established in 1955 to create and support art education programs in the community as well as to enhance and sustain the visual arts. The Center is within walking distance of Cal U. Chico, and is located 80 miles north of Sacramento and less than three hours from San Francisco.

From I-5 exit Hwy 99 South at Red Bluff, follow 99 to Chico, exit Hwy 32 West, approx 3 miles turn right on Orange Street.

From Hwy 99 North, exit Hwy 32 West, approx 3 miles turn right on Orange Street.

About the Juror

Chico Art Center is honored to welcome Peter Frank as juror for All Media 2011. Frank is Senior Curator at the Riverside Art Museum; has served as Editor of THEmagazine Los Angeles and Visions Art Quarterly; currently as art critic for Angeleno magazine and the L.A. Weekly. Frank wrote art criticism for The Village Voice and The SoHo Weekly News, and moved to Los Angeles in 1988. He contributes articles to numerous publications and has written many catalogues for one person and group exhibitions.

Frank received his Art History degree at Columbia University in the City of New York and has taught at Pratt Institute, Columbia University's School of the Arts, the Tyler School of Art, the University of California Irvine, Claremont Graduate School, California State University Fullerton, the University of California Santa Barbara, the University of California Los Angeles, Laguna College of Art and Design, Mt. San Antonio College, and other institutions.

Accepted Works

- UPS, Federal Express Shipping, or hand delivered only (no US Post Office)
- If work is not for sale it must include a prepaid return shipping label (no checks for return shipping will be accepted) Artists of unsold works will be notified at show end to arrange return shipping.

Shipping Instructions for Accepted Art Works

1. All works must be sent in reusable boxes/containers and returned by Federal Express or United Parcel Services. **Do not use US Mail.**
2. **No styrofoam peanuts or shredded paper.** Use styrofoam sheets, foam rubber, bubblewrap, or other.
3. Shipped work must arrive by July 18th, 6pm.

Call for Entries

The Chico Art Center is proud to announce "All Media 2011", a national juried art exhibition intended to showcase the diversity found in art today.

Awards

\$1,750 in Cash Awards* (\$1,000 first, \$500 second, \$250 third), and a Solo Show Award.

*Contingent on number of entries

Eligibility

Open to artists 18 or older residing in the US.

Rules of Entry

All entries must be originals, no copies, prints or reproductions of an original artwork. **No work previously shown at the Chico Art Center (including the gift shop) may be submitted.** All visual media considered except installation and performance.

Entry and Fee

A non-refundable \$25 entry fee for two works. Additional entries \$10 each. No limit. Copies of entry form accepted. Make checks payable to the Chico Art Center or use credit card or Paypal on our website. **A SASE must be included with entry form for notification and return of media.**

Donation

Work can be for sale and artists agree to donate a 30% commission to the Chico Art Center for sales resulting from this exhibition.

Specifications

- All entries must be received no later than June 17 to be considered for judging.

- Accepted works to be sent UPS or Federal Express only. **Use these shippers only, DO NOT USE US MAIL.**

- All work must be able to be moved by one person. No entries to exceed 80 lbs.

- Artist is responsible for all shipping (including return shipping). Insurance to be provided by the artist, if desired.

- 2D or wall-mounted work must not exceed 54" wide by 76" high, including frame. **No exceptions.**

- No wet work will be accepted.

- Hanging work must use eye hooks and braided wire. **NO sawtooth hangers. Use Plexiglas for shipped works, no glass.**

- Work not suitably prepared for hanging will be hung at the discretion of the CAC unless rejected as a result of.

- CAC will not open frames to clean the inside of the glass. It is the artist's responsibility to check for debris or fingerprints before shipping the work. Work under glass arriving unclean may be rejected.

- Each work must have your name and title on back or bottom, if sculpture.

- No title or price changes after time of acceptance.

- No accepted entry may be removed from the gallery prior to the close of the exhibition. No exceptions.

- A \$35 storage fee will be charged for hand delivered works not picked up after 30 days of pick-up date. Works not picked up after 90 days will be considered abandoned and become property of CAC.

- CAC reserves the right to reject an accepted work that does not match the image submitted to the juror or determined unfit for exhibit.

Image Release

Chico Art Center reserves the right to use entry images or to photograph entries for purposes of documentation, education, and publicity.

Liability

Every reasonable precaution will be taken during the receiving, installation, exhibition, and return of work. Chico Art Center will assume no responsibility for loss or damage incurred. Artists should carry their own insurance. Work should not be so fragile that public display is potentially harmful to the work or the viewer.

Format of Entries

Entries can be submitted as slides, CD images (jpgs) photographs or electronic entries. Each format must include a title list complete with title, size, and medium to correspond with each image submitted.

Slides

Slides must be 35mm, cardboard or standard thickness plastic mounts (no glass taped mounts). Label with the artist's name, title of work, entry number, medium dimensions and indicate top. Submit slides in clear plastic slide sheets. One slide per 2D entry, 2 slides each for 3D work. **PLEASE PRINT LEGIBLY WITH PEN.**

Photographs

Photographs must be no larger than 8"x10" and show the artwork in its entirety. One photograph per 2D entry, 2 per each 3D work.

CD Images

CD must contain jpg format images only (one image per 2D entry, 2 images per 3D entry). Images should be high quality, numbered, and identified with a separate corresponding title list.
