Requirements:

- One artwork per student. A completed and signed entry form must accompany artwork.
- Each school may submit up to **fifteen (15)** 2D works and five (**5**) 3D works, for a maximum of **20**.
- 2D work must not exceed 36" x 36", including frame. **NO Exceptions**
- All 2D work other than paintings must be framed under glass or plexiglass.e.g., drawings, photos,etc.
- Hanging work must use eye hooks and braided wire strong enough to support its weight. **No string.**
- Sawtooth hangers will be accepted only if frame will not support eye hooks, e.g. too thin, or plastic.
- Paintings not framed must have painted edges. All work must be completely dry. No exceptions.
- Multiples of prints will not be offered for sale at this exhibition. No exceptions.
- In the event of a sale, if the frame is not included in the price the artist or teacher will be responsible for removing the artwork from the frame after the exhibit has been removed from the gallery.
- 3D works should not be too fragile; large work must be able to be moved by one person.
- Each work must have the artist's full name and title taped on the front , if 3D, securely attached to it.
